Types of Collocations IELTS

There are six common types of collocations which we have listed below,

- Adjective + Noun
- Noun + Noun (such as collective nouns)
- Verb + Noun
- Adverb + Adjective
- Verb + prepositional phrase (phrasal verbs)
- Verb + Adverb

Examples

- 1. Adjective + Noun
 - My neighbour is proud of her **intelligent son**
 - Yesterday, in our place, there was heavy rain which really caused a lot of trouble
 - Physics is an **amazing subject** that made me think in different possible ways.

- Her boyfriend was attracted to **valuable accessories** which cost him thousands of rupees.
- My parents made me join swimming class since I showed keen interest in swimming
- One friend of mine told me that his **poor handwriting** is became a cause of his mark reduction
- 2. Noun + Noun
 - According to the data, people love to watch more **thriller movies**.
 - One of the **Indian car** manufacturers became the richest man in the world.
 - The entertainment industry seizes almost all the spheres of our life.
 - Police officers found the culprit by using the lie detector
- 3. Verb + Noun
 - I told him to have a drink in a friendly manner, but he reacted cruelly.
 - My friend **broke the law**, so he has to be in prison for 2 months.
 - Pay attention while I am talking to you or else don't speak to me hereafter.
 - She has to **save money** in order to pay her daughter's college fee.
 - When you are **reading a book**, take notes. It will help you to remember important points and ideas.
- 4. Adverb + Adjective
