#### **Visitors attractions in southern England**

Visitors can travel back in time at Blackthorn Castle, and it's a well, historically realistic, recreated castle and village. Wander the grounds and enjoy the atmosphere of a previous era. The type of sheep that the native settlers of the castle undoubtedly maintained may be seen in the pastures. Snacks made from scratch are available to buy.

Regardless of the season, visitors will love a visit to Withney Wetland Centre. In the winter, for instance, they can watch thousands of swans eat on the water from the observatory's centrally heated viewing platform. Trained wardens provide educational talks or lead guided tours of the site. The visitors' centre can also be booked for personal or business occasions.

Headley Hall is a big seventeenth-century country home that has been maintained in its original condition. Take a little time to admire the different works of art on display, and make a visit to the big kitchen, which is furnished with antique equipment and conducts demonstrations on weekends. There is an area for younger people to run around in the park, and also picnic tables.

Frank Lewis, a well known eighteenth-century painter, was born in Lewis House. Here are more of his masterpieces on show than anywhere else on the globe. Visitors can see Lewis's studio along with some of the things he used often.

Island Magic, a new walk-through exhibition at Canford Wildlife Centre, is now available. Visitors can see different animals native to Madagascar's tropical island and know about some of the important conservation work underway to protect endangered species from extinction.

The Oakwell Museum is a wonderful place for families to explore. They can go to the children's exhibit, which represents a huge playroom, and hear the stories presented by performers dressed in period clothes. They can also enjoy the period's popular games and wooden creatures.
