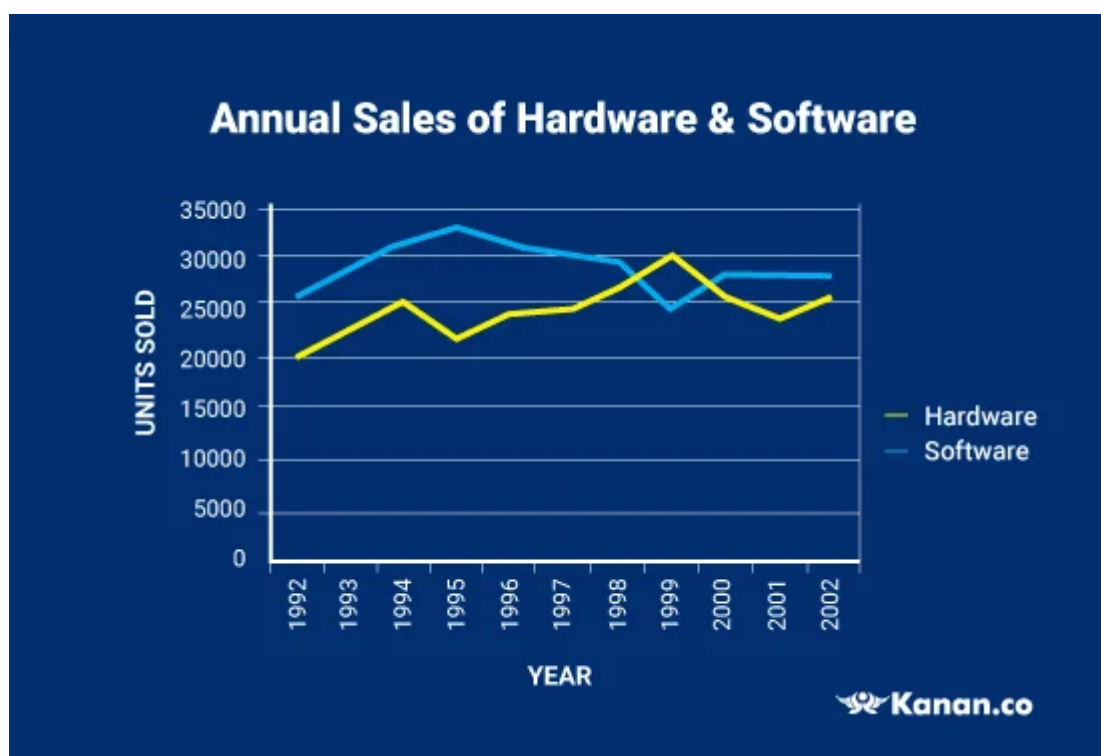


PTE Describe Image Practice Test 3

Sample Answer Introduction: This line graph indicates annual sales of hardware and software from the year 1992 to 2002.

Sample Answer Description:

In 1992, 20,000 hardware units and 25,000 software units were sold. Hardware sales showed a **steady increase** until 1999 when they **dropped back** to 25,000 units by 2002. In contrast, software sales experienced a **sharp rise**, returning to their initial 20,000-unit level in 1999.

Sample Answer Conclusion:

In conclusion, Software sales exceeded hardware sales during the 10-year period. The sale performance of hardware is less beneficial except for the noteworthy performance in the year 1999.
