

17 PTE Reading Tips, Tricks and Strategies to Score Well 2023

1. Understand the Question

The first important tip in PTE Reading is to understand the question. If you read a question twice and locate keywords, you can easily understand the question and answer based on the question type.

2. Scanning and Skimming

To read fast, you must do scanning and skimming. It not only improves your reading speed but also your attention to details. You can skim and scan through the text to get the main idea of the passage, and locate the answers correctly. This tip is helpful for the fill in the blanks question type.

3. Highlight the Keywords

In the PTE reading passage, pay attention to “clue” words like names, locations, facts and figures, you must note them down. These are keywords you need to highlight and use them while answering the questions. For multiple-choice questions, this reading tip is the best as it covers all vocabulary and phrases.

4. Analyse the Text

After going through the passage once, read the passage in detail to analyse the text. It gives a precise meaning and helps you to identify the answer. If you're strong in grammar and collocations, you can analyse the text easily. This technique is useful for both short articles and long-form paragraphs.

5. Use the Elimination Method

For MCQs (multiple-choice questions), use the elimination method. This strategy is effective because it eliminates the irrelevant possibilities and gives you the correct answer. This elimination technique is effective for both ‘single answer’ and ‘multiple answers’ questions.

6. Improve Time Management

In the [PTE exam pattern](#), the reading test format alone is 30 minutes long and contains five question types. If you use your time wisely, your time management skills improve. So spend no more than 2 minutes per question. While practising, aim to read at least 220 words per minute. Once you're happy with comprehension and reading speed, focus on chunks (group of words) instead of individual words.

7. Double-check your Answers

After completing the test ahead of time, always double-check your answers. It will reduce 60% of common errors such as spelling and grammatical errors, choosing wrong answers, etc. It is one of the important PTE exam reading tips that need to be followed.

8. Use The Correct Collocation

While practising every day, make sure you use the correct collocation. Collocation is a combination of words in a sentence, often linked together. For the fill in the blanks question type, identify answers with common collocations used for a specific word or phrase.

9. Prepare a Dictionary

Preparing a personalised dictionary is an important PTE reading strategy for first-time test takers. You can create a dictionary by marking new words from newspapers, magazines, or any other article. Even if the words are unfamiliar, note them on a separate paper with their meanings for future reference.

10. Read What You Like

To improve your English skills, read what you like. It can be books, blogs, research summaries, news, or even online PTE resources. Since reading is a monotonous activity, you can choose different genres or themes to retain your interest.

11. Seek Help from Family and Friends

Generally, self-learners seek help from their family and friends during their PTE preparation. Getting help from family and friends is a basic PTE reading trick to learn effortlessly. It gives a suitable environment for speed reading and identifying mistakes.

12. Improve your Grammar

Grammar is the foundation of any language, and it's crucial to have a strong command of it for the PTE reading test. Hence, one of the best PTE reading grammar tips is focusing on tenses and the different parts of speech, like nouns, verbs, pronouns, adjectives and adverbs. To delve deeper, understand the subject-verb agreement, singular/plural, idioms, and prepositions.

13. Practice Tests

Practice tests are the change-makers. By practising more samples and mock tests online, you are likely to achieve your targeted score. Pearson's PTE practice test is a good study material for students to practise and develop their reading skills. It also contains guidelines for effective reading strategies.

Now, we will see the PTE reading tips and tricks for each question type below.

14. Multiple-Choice, Choose Single Answer

You need to understand the main idea and supporting details of the passage, locate keywords and answer the question. Since 65% of the answers lie in the first or last two lines, use scanning and skimming techniques. Learn to paraphrase. That is, convey the same information using synonyms and different words.

15. Multiple-Choice, Choose Multiple Answers

In multiple-choice: choose multiple answers, you need more time than the MCQ: choose single answer question type. You can read the stem and options twice to find the text that contains information. Note repeated words (if any). Since the "multiple-choice: choose multiple answers" has negative markings, do not choose an incorrect choice. Instead, you can leave it blank to avoid losing points.

16. Re-order Paragraphs

To score in re-order paragraphs, search for a headline and a major idea. Arrange the sentences in a logical sequence as there is one mark given for each correct pair. Check out the contradictory words/phrases such as however, but, although. And, use additional phrases like also, moreover, furthermore, besides, on top of that, etc.

17. Fill in the Blanks

Fill in the blanks question type does not have negative marking, so answer all questions. To fill in the missing words, focus on the parts of speech before and after the text and look for synonyms. One of the important PTE reading fill up tips is vocabulary building.

PTE Reading Test Format

PTE Reading test evaluates your overall reading skills through five different question types. You will get 30 minutes (half-an-hour) time to finish the test. Below is the PTE Reading test format:
