Study Permit Extension Checklist

Here we list the documents needed for applying for **Study Permit Extension**

- 1. The scanned copy of the passport with passport number, date of issue and expiry, stamps, and Visas from the visited countries.
- 2. Digital photo of yours.
- 3. The scanned copy of the current study permit.
- 4. Revised letter of acceptance, and confirmation of enrollment.
- 5. An official bank statement that includes the Canadian bank's name and address, your name and address as proof of funds enough to support your studies and living.
- 6. Make sure the documents presented are in English or in French. Else translate the copies and attach an affidavit from the authorized person who translated the documents.

Here are some additional documents that you might need depending on specific circumstances.

- 1. **Letter of Explanation:** It is a good option to describe additional factors like the purpose of your application, Additional information if you have run out of space in the document.
- 2. **Medical Exam**: You do not need proof of medical exams until you lived in any designated country for more than 6 months or if you need to work in any public health, health science, or agricultural sector.
- 3. **Family Information Form:** This is a must if it is included in the document checklist. You need to download the form, fill and sign it by hand, scan and then upload the signed document again.
- 4. **Biometrics**: This is needed only when you haven't submitted the biometrics previously. These are needed once in 10 years only. You need to pay the fee and submit your biometrics at a designated Service Canada location.
